### RESPONSIBILITIES

A position is available for a Medical Technologist (ASCP) or Medical Lab Technician. Position can be full time or part time, will primarily be 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> shift, and will include weekends and holidays as scheduled. Bachelors or Associates Degree in Medical Technology or related science, or certification as a Medical Lab Technician or equivalent required. Previous experience preferred and must possess knowledge sufficient to meet recognized agency certification with the American Society of Clinical Pathologists or equivalent. Must possess good interpersonal skills. Visual acuity and color discrimination required. Knowledge of laboratory procedures and standards required. Must have an understanding of the equipment and related supplies used.

As required with all clinical positions, appropriate masking and eye wear may be required when providing direct patient care and when working in clinical departments.

**PHYSICAL DEMANDS:** Repetitive typing/arm motion required with sitting, standing and walking short distances most of the working shift. Light lifting and reaching short distances required.
