### RESPONSIBILITIES

Full or Part Time position available working varied hours depending on patient volumes and staffing needs. Preferred cross trained to radiology technologist functions, but not required. Primary duties include performing all ultrasound techniques and examinations such as abdominal scans, retroperitoneal scans, OB/GYN scans, small parts and neonatal head scans, vascular exams and assisting with interventional procedures.

Graduate of a two year AMA Radiology Program required with one to two years experience in a hospital radiology department preferred. Ultrasound registry eligible after one year training or experience with completion of needed courses. Must be registered within one year of hire.

Criminal background clearances required to be completed on acceptance of the position with results received prior to hire. In compliance with the CMS COVID-19 Vaccination Mandate, all staff at PAH must be fully vaccinated or be approved for a qualifying exemption prior to hire.

Physical Demands: Moves throughout the department and Hospital. Required to move portable x-ray equipment, patients and other equipment. Required to assist, move and lift potentially very heavy patients (200-300 lbs.) from x-ray or scan tables.
